Becky is as Southern as a debutante ball fried in bacon drippings at heart. She also holds degrees in anthropology, fine art, and marketing. Her resume reads like a bowl of alphabet soup, with past job titles such as “professional musician” and “digital media professor.” Her real passion, however, is storytelling.

When not talking about ghosts, Becky can be found doodling spooky pictures, wrangling neurotic cats, and exasperating tweens.

Though Homespun Haints® is not scripted, Diana labors intensely gathering data for each episode and the accompanying blog. On her travels, she collects local folklore and takes ghost tours unironically.

Having inherited both a logical skepticism from her Vulcan mathematician father and a willingness to believe from her fairy energy healer mother, Diana doesn't know exactly what she believes about the paranormal, and is ok with that.

Although she has two advanced degrees, Diana works hard to be the opposite of bougie: she lives in a van down by the river (occasionally), shops at thrift stores (mostly), and eats bugs (somewhat intentionally).

Besides co-hosting and writing for the funniest first-hand ghost story podcast ever, Diana is usually learning new languages, reading about science, or cooking adventurously. She and her partner Amber host miniature soirees where they dazzle neurodivergent friends with exotic fruits, trashy 90's goth music, and filthy-yet-intellectual party games.
